

Sakhalin gray whales. 4 days/3 nights. July-August. 2-15 PAX

The sea giants attract many tourists from all over the world. We invite you to an amazing trip to the north of Sakhalin, the coast of the Sea of Okhotsk, where you can see gray whales.



The population of northern whales walking around the coast of Sakhalin has more than 150 individuals and very often groups of 3-5 whales can be found. The gray whale is one of the "12 greatest whales." The weight of an adult whale reaches 30 tons, and the average length is about 13 meters. The life expectancy of a gray whale is about 60 years.

ITINERARY (short):

Day 1 – Meeting in Yuzhno-Sakhalinsk. Train to the north of the island, in Nogliki.

Day 2 – Arrival to Nogliki. Transfer to Piltun Bay. Travel time is about 4 hours. Arrival at the place, accommodation in the camp. Watching whales and seals.

Day 3 – Watching whales. If weather is suitable, we organize boat trips to the sea. At lunch departure to Nogliki. Train departure to Yuzhno-Sakhalinsk.

Day 4 – Arrival in Yuzhno-Sakhalinsk in the morning.
